3. Features of a Site MiLab User Account

If you are affiliated with the site, we strongly urge you to foster good communication with your supporting laboratories, so you are aware of the completion status of each required element for laboratory approval.

To assist the site in tracking the status of the MiPAL, site users have access to the current list of all of their supporting laboratories, as well as the MiPAL information for each study in which the site is participating.

So, you can see this information here on the site homepage presented. On the left is a list of Affiliated Sites. To the right, are the list of any Affiliated Labs associated with those sites. And then, next are the list of the available PALs for which the site is currently participating.

So, if the laboratories that will be used are not listed under your affiliated laboratories, so that's those laboratories that will be completing your PALs, please contact the laboratory center so that we can add them to your list and give the laboratory access to provide that required testing information.

All laboratories that are affiliated with the site will be able to access the PALs to complete the sections appropriate to the testing they'll be performing. So, all users who access the PAL will be tracked via an auto-login. Any affiliated users may submit the PAL to the lab center once it's complete.
